
MARK DAVIDSON PROVES THAT WHAT HAS BEEN TAUGHT ABOUT THE END-TIMES IS WRONG

- The invasion of the whole Middle East by Iran,
- A future Sunni confederacy, and
- The Antichrist's rise to power step-by-step.
