Suggested Interview Questions for:

Daniel Revisited, by Mark Davidson

- 1. Popular belief tells us that the Rapture or Tribulation is the next prophetic event. Your book says this is not true. Tell us about that.
- 2. Why do you say Daniel 7 and 8 are not about ancient times but about end times?
- 3. In Daniel Revisited you show how Daniel 7 and 8 form four great events, which you call the Four Signposts. Tell us about these.
- 4. What got your attention about the four horsemen being connected to these Four Signposts?
- 5. Tell us about these four events, the Four Signposts, you wrote about in Daniel Revisited. What are they?
- 6. Why is this information only coming out now and not before?
- 7. What is the major assumption, you believe, that is getting in the way of our seeing Daniel clearly?
- 8. Getting back to the Four Signposts that you described earlier, the First Signpost has already occurred and you are saying then that the next event is the invasion of the Middle East by Iran. How close would you say are we to the start of the Second Signpost, the invasion by Iran?
- 9. How widely might this invasion by Iran be felt? What might its impact be?
- 10. You say also in Daniel Revisited that the second horn of the Persian ram which is to grow up longer and later than the first horn has been fulfilled. Tell us about that, and why is this significant.
- 11. Although America is not mentioned specifically in the Bible you say its actions are mentioned in the Bible. Tell us about that.
- 12. What do you hope readers will gain after reading Daniel Revisited?
