Written in a fictional dialogue style, it is a story of Mike Branch, a brother who visits with a renowned pastor and shares the message of the next great event to occur according to Bible prophecy, Iran's invasion of the Middle East. The book covers the points of Daniel 8, the vision of the ram and the goat, and shows how the vision actually applies to our time, with Iran as the Persian ram, and modern Iran fulfilling the prophecy of the ram's second horn growing up later. The talk begins with verses 17 and 19, which surprisingly and obviously tell us, the vision pertains to the end time.
